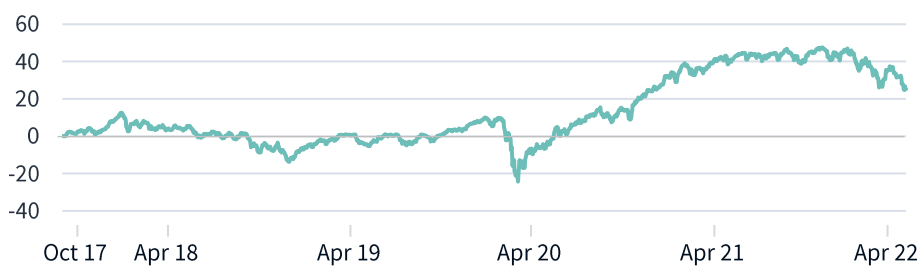
Investment Objective and Policy Summary

The investment objective of the Fund is to seek to achieve a return for investors over the medium to long term based on a combination of capital growth and income and with a medium to high volatility level mainly through exposure to a diversified range of equity sub-asset classes. The fund intends to hold a minimum of 50% and less than 100% of its Net Asset Value in Collective Investment Schemes (CIS). The CIS in which the Fund will invest will have a range of underlying investments which may reflect

exposure to equities and/or equity-related securities, money market instruments, financial derivative instruments, financial indices and/or currencies. In addition to investment in CIS, the Fund may invest directly in equities, units or shares of Real Estate Investment Trusts and equity-related securities. Investments will be made following qualitative and quantitative assessments that are determined by the Manager and based on the Manager's views as to an appropriate allocation strategy.

COMMENTARY

Central banks became more hawkish, with the US Fed indicating a 50 basis points rate hike in May. The Shanghai lockdown entered a second month, threatening the country's 5.5% growth target for 2022. Russia halted gas supplies to Poland and Bulgaria, labelling them as "unfriendly" countries.

Equities retreated, led by US stocks. The S&P 500 Index dropped 8.8%, while the tech-heavy Nasdaq Index plunged 13.3%. European equities held up relatively well, with commodity-related sectors showing resilience. Chinese equities recovered some ground towards month-end after further support was promised. The fund fell in April on the back of a steep sell-off in equity markets globally, as shares were hit by the ongoing war in Ukraine, lockdowns in China exacerbating supply chain disruptions, and rising US interest rate expectations. EU and value tilted stocks fared better than US growth stocks. Thus, exposures to value biased

holdings such as iShares Edge MSCI Europe Value Factor ETF, helped the fund. Poor market index performances materially hurt the fund, particularly iShares North America Index Fund. From a sector-level perspective energy companies performed the strongest, whereas tech and communication services lagged. Hence Asian, tech-heavy equity holdings hurt performance with Fidelity Asia Pacific Opps being amongst the cohort of underperformers. Robeco BP US Premium Equities and Selection US were the standouts with both funds' strategies successfully outperforming their benchmarks.

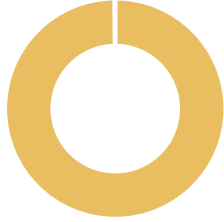
